Working with men who perpetrate family violence and abuse

Delivered by No to Violence over **4 days**, this non-accredited course will provide professionals working directly with men choosing to use violence and abuse with the early skills, knowledge and confidence to interrupt abusive attitudes, and engage in meaningful conversations that work to move men choosing to use violence and abuse into a change journey.

This course will provide foundational knowledge in men's family violence work, to support professionals keen to begin working effectively with this complex client cohort. Bring your existing experience in human service work to build your knowledge and skill in:

1. Understanding coercive control and the ways to identify the coercive control pattern
2. Engaging more effectively with men in discussions about their choice to use violence and abuse
3. Working collaboratively with other specialists and specialist services centred on the safety and wellbeing of women and children
4. Understanding the importance of inviting men using family violence and abuse to a behavioural change journey by attending the masterclass 'Stages of Change'.
